ID AYU0084) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely, **Shri Kalidas Ayurvedic Medical College, Banashankari Road, Post: Badami, Distt. Bagalkot-587201 Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0084)** inspection of your College was conducted on **05.06.2023 & 06.06.2023 on hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed In terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **54th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **22.08.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria. Hence the Board decided to issue conditional permission for conducting 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.**
- Therefore, **Conditional Permission is granted to, Shri Kalidas Ayurvedic Medical College, Banashankari Road, Post: Badami, Distt. Bagalkot-587201 Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0084) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24** subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
 - The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the colleges/hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant rules and regulations.
 - It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with **60 seats** shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the**

aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.

- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
6. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular or the subsequent academic year.**
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
8. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2024-25: -**
- i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda).
- iii) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Shri Kalidas Ayurvedic Medical College Badami - 587201 Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0084)**, inspection of your College was conducted on **01.02.2024 & 02.02.2024 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2024-25.**
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education regulation, 2022, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **96th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **05.07.2024**. The Board discussed and decided to grant an opportunity of clarification to the college on certain shortcomings observed during the assessment.
- The same was communicated to the college vide letter of even number dated 22.07.2024. In response of the same, a clarification has been received from the college vide letter ref. no. SKAMC/2024-25/198 dated 27.07.2024. After analyzing the clarification, **your college is not fulfilling the notified and approved criteria due to the following shortcoming:-**

a) Teaching staffs:-

Availability of total teaching staff for UG is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{28}{30} \times 100\% = 93.3\%$ (Excluding Excess and considering visitor observation report)

5. However, as per regulation 3(3) of MSR, 2016, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for conditional permission for the academic year 2024-25. Hence the Board decided to issue the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25.
6. Therefore, **Conditional Permission is granted to Shri Kalidas Ayurvedic Medical College Badami – 587201 Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0084) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25, subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following conditions as mentioned below: -**
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats** shall be treated as All India Quota.  - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 - The shortcoming mentioned in Point no. 4.

Bagalkot-587201 Karnataka (Inst. Id-AYU0084)**, inspection was conducted on **03.04.2025 & 04.04.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to process the permission with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under. **On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcoming:**

I. Teaching staffs :-
For UG Course:-

- a) Availability of total teaching staff for UG(BAMS) course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{28}{30} \times 100\% = 93.33\%$ (Excluding Excess).

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II. Mean of general and essential equipments/instruments availability is 99.60%.

Further, the assessment report was duly placed before the 137th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 30.07.2025 and Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned acts and regulations, but is fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letters issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Further, the Board also observed that the college is meeting the notified & requisite criteria for the issuance of the Extended Permission for 60 seats in UG as per regulation 54(2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 by getting permitted for the last three consecutive years. Accordingly, the Board decided as follows:

To issue Extended Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

- Therefore, Shri Kalidas Ayurvedic Medical College, Banashankari Road, Post: Badami, Distt. Bagalkot-587201 Karnataka (Inst. Id-AYU0084) is hereby granted with:-

Extended permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024.

The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-

- Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- You are hereby instructed to comply with all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**

8. The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirement of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standard of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
- iv) The compliance of shortcoming mentioned in para- 02.

9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
